


## WE ARE DELIGHTED TO TELL YOU ABOUT THE ST ANDREW'S PROJECT...



## HELP US TO REALISE THIS INSPIRATIONAL PROJECT

From the outset the College has benefited from the generosity of its community. Making provision for bursaries was a founding principle of the College, with one in ten pupils selected from families of talented boys who could not afford the school fees being sponsored by fee-paying parents. This principle continues in the Bradfield Foundation and since then, fundraising has expanded to capital projects and enabled the development of some of the most iconic buildings on campus, including the Sports Complex, the Blackburn Science Centre and the Greek Theatre. It is only through the support of our alumni, parents, former parents and staff that the College has achieved its current strong position.


