



THE ST ANDREW'S CONCEPT

“ ST ANDREWS IS SQUARELY A TEACHING AND LEARNING PROJECT; A REFLECTION OF BRADFIELD'S CURRICULUM AND A MANIFESTATION OF OUR RESPONSIBILITY TO PREPARE OUR PUPILS TO WORK AND STUDY IN THE 21ST CENTURY. WE ARE AWARE THAT CONTEMPORARY EDUCATION WILL SHIFT TO INVOLVE MORE SELF-DIRECTED LEARNING AS PUPILS, TEACHERS AND TUTORS MOVE TO LEVERAGE ONLINE OPPORTUNITIES. SIMILARLY, THE WORLD OF WORK WILL DIVERSIFY INTO DIFFERENT FORMS OF HYBRID WORKING, WHETHER, AT HOME OR IN AN OFFICE, ON OR OFFLINE. 


HELP US TO REALISE THIS INSPIRATIONAL PROJECT

From the outset the College has benefited from the generosity of its community. Making provision for bursaries was a founding principle of the College, with one in ten pupils selected from families of talented boys who could not afford the school fees being sponsored by fee-paying parents. 
