Having been on a tour of the College you will be asked to complete the application form(s) for a place. The form will request the following personal data:

- Your child's names, date of birth, birth certificate number, current school, first language and any relevant medical or educational information;
- The names and contact details of parents and guardians, as well as their relationship to the child.

The College will retain your personal data for the purpose of processing, progressing and assessing your application for a place. Our legal basis for this processing is our legitimate interest to recruit new students.

If your application is not successful, we will retain the data for 1 year before deleting.

If your application is successful then we will retain the data contained in the admission documents, parent contracts, registrations forms, letters of offer and acceptance, and all other data connected with the admissions process for a period of six years from the date of the pupil leaving the College.

At the conclusion of all relevant retention periods, physical documents containing your personal data will be shredded, and all personal data held electronically will be deleted.

You have the qualified right to request:

Access to and porting of your data;
Rectification or erasure of the data;
Restriction of processing or to object to the processing.
