When you apply for a Bursary with Bradfield College the data you provide with your application is used to assess your suitability and determine whether a bursary award is appropriate and justified. This data includes your personal details such as name and address, details about other dependants and extensive financial details including income, assets, investments, liabilities, and banking details.

Our legal basis for this processing is that you are entering into a contract.

If we are unable to process this data we will not be able to move forward with assessing your suitability for a bursary or continue to provide a bursary if one has already been granted.

We will pass your data to a third party agent specifically for the purpose of the determination of your application for a Bursary or other form of fee assistance. Their details and Privacy Notice can be found on the Bursary Application portal.

If the application is unsuccessful your data will be retained for 3 months and then deleted..

If the application is successful we will retain your data until your child leaves Bradfield College.

At the conclusion of all relevant retention periods, physical documents containing your personal data will be shredded, and all personal data held electronically will be deleted.

You have the qualified right to request:

Access to and porting of your data;
Rectification or erasure of the data;
Restriction of processing or to object to the processing.
