WELCOME

Dear Parents

In September 2026, Bradfield College is launching a new day option for local families and a key part of that offer is a new daily transport network running Monday to Saturday mornings and Monday to Friday evenings. We are delighted to be working with Green Metro Cars to run these services. Green Metro are very experienced in running daily transport networks for independent schools and offer a range of service for parents including: real time updates, an easy-to-use app and continuity of drivers who are all vetted and subject to rigorous safeguarding and first aid training.

As this is the first year we are running daily transport we are asking parents to now indicate what days they would like to use the serviced outlines in the guide by [completing this form](#). The final routes and timings will be confirmed based on responses received by Monday 8 June 2026 and the running of a route will depend on a minimum number of pupils per day so please can I encourage you to include all the journeys you are considering using transport for. To help you make your decision, the guide includes timings for the start of the day for each year group so you can see when they have chapel or assembly as we cannot guarantee transport arriving in time for breakfast (for Day Boarders) on those days. We have also included the proposed Co-curricular timetable for the Michaelmas term so you can see what activities your child may want to be involved in in the evenings. For certain evening activities a supper and supervision charge of £12 will be applied for day pupils.

We will then ask you to confirm the transport you need in early July and you will then be charged for the whole term in advance in August. After payment we will not be able to reduce your agreed journeys for the Michaelmas Term as we will have committed to running the service. We may be able to increase your journeys during the term, subject to availability.

As the number of day pupils grows in the coming years we hope to introduce more flexibility around booking journeys on a more-ad-hoc basis. If you have any questions about the new transport arrangements please contact admissions@bradfieldcollege.org.uk

TERMS & CONDITIONS

1. This agreement is made between all college transport passengers, their parents and Bradfield College in order to provide safe, comfortable and civilised journeys for all passengers.

2. Arrangements for pupils' journeys to and from college are the responsibility of their parents. To assist with discharging this responsibility, the College provides a daily transport service. Parents are responsible for their children at all times including both prior to boarding and after alighting.

3. Transport on the College daily transport service must be booked and paid termly in advance.

4. Bookings are generally non-refundable in the event of a pupil failing to travel.

5. Each pupil will be added to a list detailing the service they travel on and their stop. Their name will appear on a list which will be checked by the driver.

6. It will be the parent's responsibility to inform the College in advance of the deadline for committing to the following term if they no longer wish for their child to use the daily transport.

7. No pupil is permitted to travel on the daily transport service if not pre-booked. Other arrangements for journeys to and from college must be made by the pupil or their parents.

8. Pupils should be at the stop five minutes before the scheduled time of departure. Drivers will not wait past the scheduled departure time.

9. Good conduct is required at all times. Shouting, use of inappropriate language, dropping litter, playing loud music or any other misbehaviour is strictly forbidden, and pupils must not needlessly talk or distract the driver. Pupils must ensure that any online activity will not cause distress to others and normal college sanctions, or breach of guidelines, will be enforced.

10. Except when embarking or disembarking, or when asked to move to a different seat in accordance with condition, all passengers must remain seated with their seatbelts fastened correctly.

11. Failure to comply with these conditions may result in the matter being referred to the Deputy Head, Pastoral and may result in disciplinary action, including temporary or permanent withdrawal of permission to use the daily home to school service

12. Bradfield College aims for 95% of journeys to operate within the transport industry window of tolerance of one minute early to five minutes late, however timings may vary due to traffic conditions or unforeseen circumstances. There may be some adjustment needed to the timings in the first weeks of term when new routes are introduced.

13. The College reserves the right to amend or withdraw published services, having provided one month's notice, for instance if there is insufficient demand for operational reasons
